

HomeGrown Art Show Artist Information Annual Celebration of Original Community Art

In order to participate:

1. You must reside in the Bow Valley to participate in the show. (Home street address is Banff, Lake Louise, Canmore or Exshaw).
2. You must provide a brief typed bio (one paragraph) with a description of your art piece. This can be submitted with your application and payment at Town Hall or emailed to homegrown@banff.ca by Wednesday, February 13, 2019 after payment has been arranged by phone.
3. A **\$30 entrance fee (submissions from 18+)** or a **\$20 entrance fee (submissions from 17 and under)** is required to offset the cost of set-up and the opening night reception.
4. **Artwork must be submitted by February 22.** All submissions must be suitably framed, wired and ready to install, if it is not, you risk the chance of your piece not being displayed.
5. Please drop off your submission between 8:30 am . 4:30 pm to:

6. Artwork may be picked up after the Homegrown exhibit from Town Hall any time after Monday, April 1, 2019 between 8:30am . 4:30pm. Submissions must be picked up no later than Friday, April 5. The Town of Banff will not be responsible for artwork left after Friday, April 5, 2019.
7. Artists should plan to attend and volunteer at the **Homegrown Opening Reception at Town Hall on Friday, March 1 from 7 - 9 p.m.**
8. If you are selling your artwork, you will be responsible for all aspects of the transaction, including contacting purchaser, financial agreements and the transfer of art **AFTER** completion of the Homegrown show. There will be no exceptions.
9. Your artwork should be insured, as the Town of Banff will not be held liable for any damage.
10. Please pick up invitations to the Opening Reception from Community Services during the month of February to hand out to friends, relatives and acquaintances.

Waiver of Liability Information

This waiver of Liability between the Town of Banff and the artist waives any liability on the part of the Town of Banff or its employees with regard to a public exhibition by the Artist of his /her works of art (Works) to be held at the Town of Banff, Town Hall.

The Artist hereby agrees to hold harmless Town of Banff and/or its employees and volunteers from any liability for the Artist of the Works including but not restricted to damage to or theft of the Works.

This waiver stipulates that ownership of Works sold during the exhibition shall not be transferred from the Artist to a purchaser until after the Closing Date. Receipts made out to purchasers shall be marked **Deposit on artwork**.

It is hereby understood by and between the Town of Banff and the Artist that the only intention of the Town of Banff is to provide a venue for the exhibition of the Works during the above period and that the Town of Banff can accept no responsibility or liability for the Artists or the Works.
