

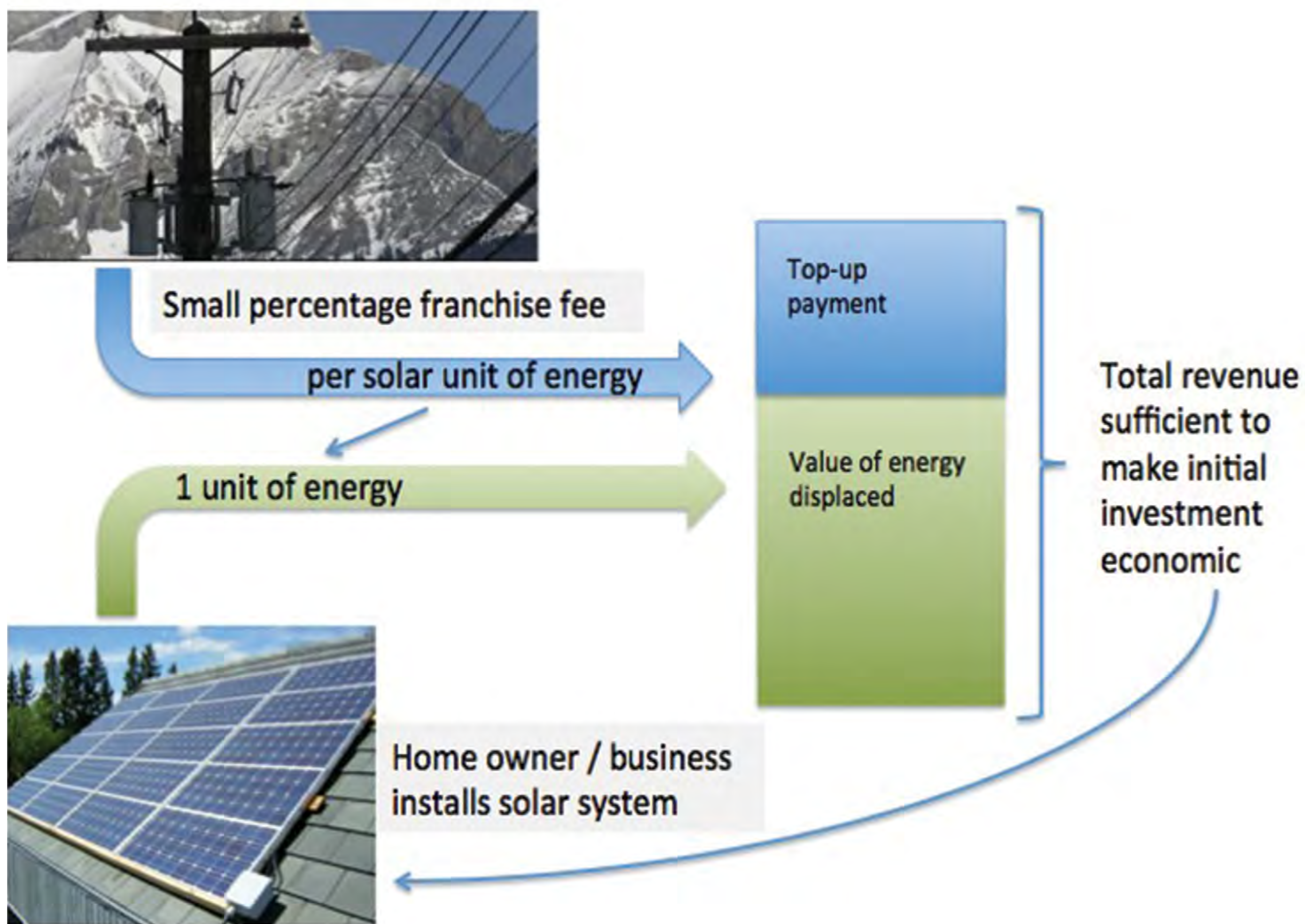
# Harnessing the Sun

THE TOWN OF BANFF SOLAR INCENTIVE PROGRAM — SUPPORTING YOU TO GO SOLAR

The program offers cost-based compensation to new solar photovoltaic energy producers, providing price certainty and long-term contracts that help finance renewable energy investments. Quarterly payments will be made by the Town, based on system production.

Last year 47 applied and 14 residents and businesses took advantage of the 2015 initiative to install solar panels on their rooftops. Their solar PV system will save them an average of \$500 a year.

Together, Banff is already harnessing 10 times more solar power than the average Alberta output of 1.28 watts per person.



## HOW IT WORKS

Homeowners, condo associations, and commercial property owners can enter the lottery. Apply online at [banff.ca/solar](http://banff.ca/solar)

- 2016 incentive supported systems must be installed by year end
- Approximately 7 year support to payback investment
- Solar PV System can be installed on shared roofs (ex. condominiums)

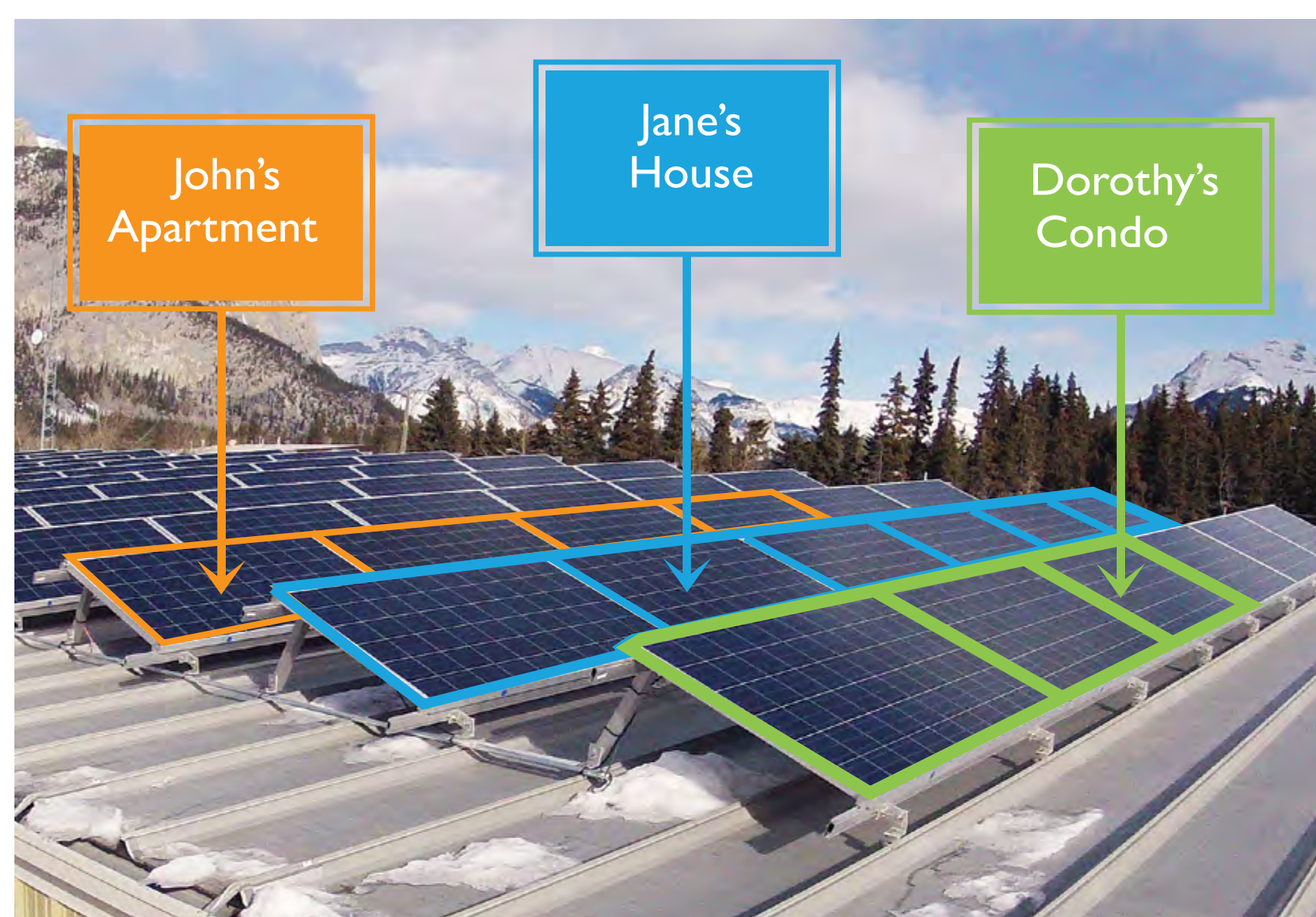

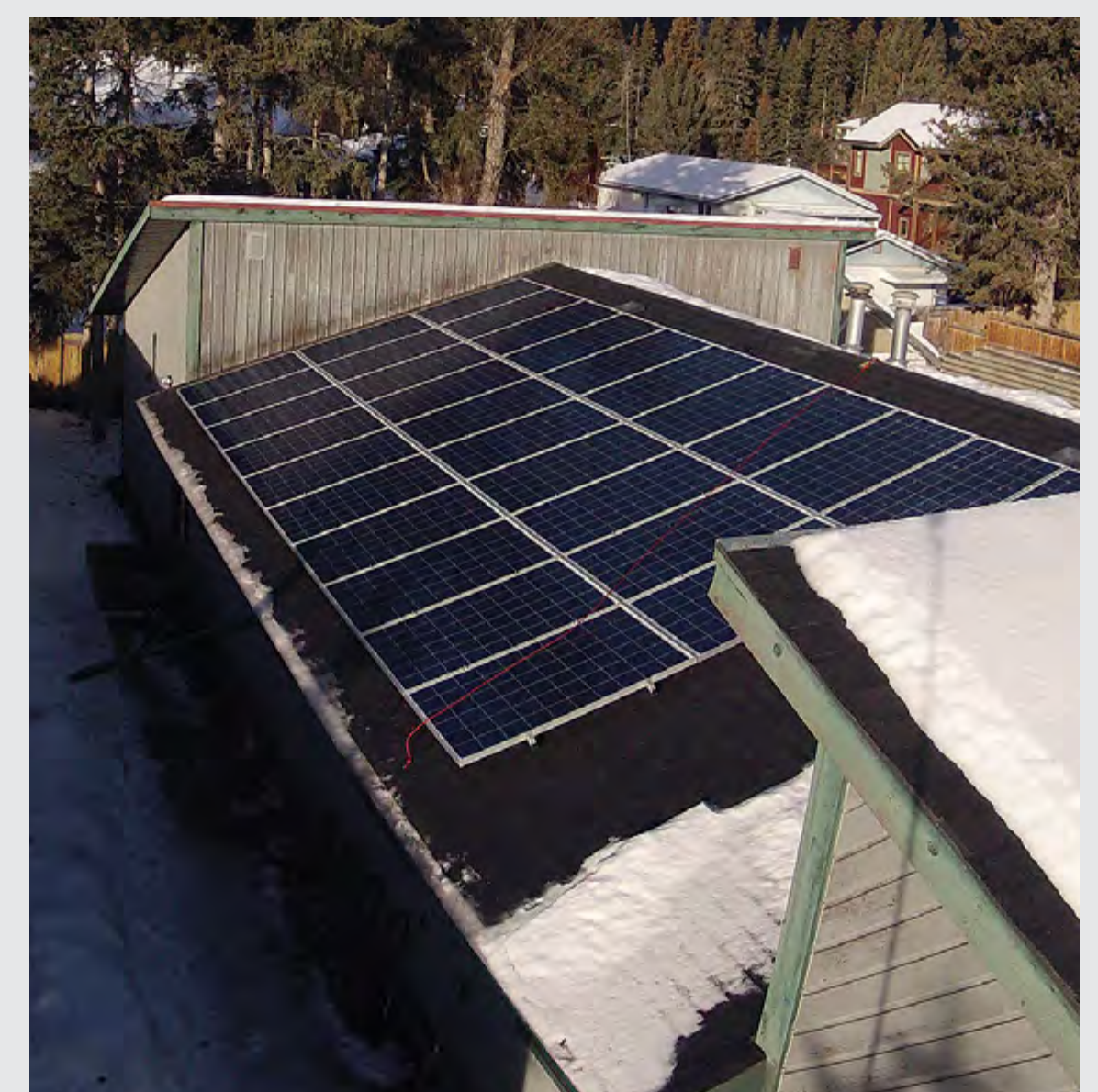
