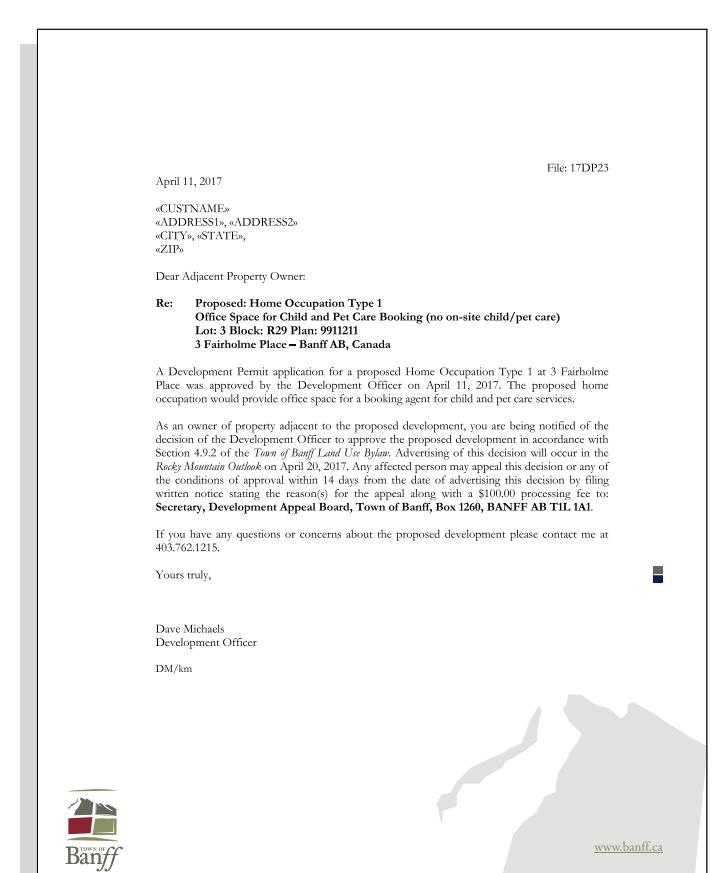
VIEW THE HISTORY OF DEVELOPMENT OF YOUR PROPERTY

Simply turn on the Closed Permits layer and click on the grey diamond to view all the development permits issued for that property since the Town's incorporation. Search by street, year, contact, roll number or description by clicking on the black arrow at the bottom of the screen to access the database, and selecting Options>Filter. See the demo.

FIND OUT EVEN MORE

Application approvals can be made either through the Town's development officer, if the application is complying with the bylaw, or the Municipal Planning Commission (MPC) if a variance or discretionary use is requested. MPC meetings are typically held on the second Wednesday of each month at 9 a.m., in the Council Chamber and are open to the public. Check the agenda on the Banff Info page, published weekly in the Rocky Mountain Outlook or online at banff.ca/agendacenter.

Once MPC makes a decision on a discretionary use or a variance is granted, a notification letter is sent to adjacent property owners and posted in the Rocky Mountain Outlook.



DID YOU KNOW

The Town requires a sign be posted on the property for all development permit applications. The sign is the responsibility of the applicant.

On large development permit applications, the Town encourages the proponent to conduct community consultation as part of the development application approval process.
