ANSWER:

Introduction of a food waste stream into the pedestrian bin program is a trial. Large amounts of single use items currently contaminate the food waste recovered in these food bins. It is anticipated that with the elimination/reduction of single use items resulting from the proposed associated bylaw cross contamination will likely reduce.

QUESTION:

Understanding we haven't seen it yet - are we expecting to see the waste diversion rate increase in time now that signage, education, and ease factors changes have been made? Is there anything else we can do at this point?

ANSWER:

Yes, we expect to see the waste diversion rate increase within the Construction/Renovation/Demolition stream in particular. We anticipate seeing a further reduction in single use items in the wastestream following the approval of the associated bylaw. Looking ahead, residential diversion is an area where additional tools and tactics may be required such as a "pay as you throw" system instead of the current format.
