



Town of Banff TRAVIS Permit Conditions

- Permit applications require a minimum of two business days for approval.
- The speed limit for all Municipal roadways is 30 kilometres per hour unless otherwise posted.
- Town of Banff does not verify routes for dimensional requirements. All responsibility rests on the permit holder to verify the approved route for all dimensional requirements prior to move to ensure the vehicle dimensions will allow for safe travel on the given route.
- The Bow River Bridge (Banff Avenue) and 40 Mile Creek Bridge (Norquay Road) both meet Alberta Transportation (AT) municipal bridge load standards.
Loads exceeding the AT municipal bridge load standards are NOT permitted to cross the 40 Mile Creek Bridge (Norquay Road).
Loads exceeding the AT municipal bridge load standards MAY be permitted to cross the Bow River Bridge (Banff Avenue) SUBJECT TO an independent structural evaluation and provision of documentation, acceptable to the Town of Banff, that demonstrates the structure is able to safely carry the proposed loads.
- A Person shall not operate on a Street or Public Place any machinery or equipment of any kind equipped with lugs, cleats, or tracks which may damage in any way the surface of the Street or Public Place.
- Parking, loading or unloading of vehicles, trailers or other equipment on Municipal roadways is prohibited, unless otherwise permitted by a Town of Banff - Street and Public Place Use Permit.
- Any restrictions to parking or traffic lanes are prohibited, unless otherwise permitted by a Town of Banff - Street and Public Place Use Permit.
