

## SHED IN BANFF 1970-1985

Shed architecture is rooted in counterpointed geometric shapes, bold angles, and multiple massing. It is primarily but not exclusively seen in Banff in larger, multi-unit residential buildings.

### Architectural Principles

- Style based in form (combined geometric shapes) rather than any ornamentation
- Multiple massing
- Multi-directional shed roofs
- Little-to-no eave overhang

### Identifying Features

- Counterpointed geometric building sections
- Vertical, horizontal or diagonal wood siding cladding, occasional wood shingle cladding
- Ribbons of clerestory windows, and windows with taller upper panes over shorter lower panes
- Rectangular, unelaborated chimneys clad in materials consistent with the building walls
