- FL-22 JOINT REQUEST FOR DIVORCE.....ORIGINAL AND 2 Copies
- FL-24 JOINT AFFIDAVIT OF APPLICANT.....ORIGINAL AND 2 Copies  
Include your original government issued marriage certificate if married in Canada  
See Resolution Services (7<sup>th</sup> floor south) to have form commissioned
- REVIEW MEMO / CHILD SUPPORT CALCULATION.....ORIGINAL  
See Resolution Services for Instructions  
Bring proof of income for both parties  
(e.g. Notice of Assessment, T4s, Tax Return etc)
- JOINT DIVORCE JUDGMENT AND COROLLARY RELIEF ORDER **\*OR\***
- JOINT DIVORCE JUDGMENT (if there are no children)  
ORIGINAL must be printed on light green paper (see Resolution Services to copy  
on green paper)  
4 copies on white paper
- TWO LARGE STAMPED, SELF ADDRESSED ENVELOPES**  
**One addressed to each of you**
